IMPORTANT INFORMATION

CSSC Scholarship Program

Reduced fees are available for low-income seniors through our scholarship program. If you need financial assistance to take a class, please request an application at the front desk.

Patron Cards

There are no membership fees at the Senior Center. We have patron cards for those who attend regularly. Please stop by the front desk to get your card. We ask that you scan your card each time you visit the center to allow us to accurately track the number of people taking advantage of our services and to demonstrate to grant funders and donors the positive impact we have on seniors' lives and well-being. The first card is free; there is a \$3 replacement fee for lost cards.

We will attempt to make up cancelled classes. Day trips are evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

The Senior Center complies with the ADA and will make reasonable accommodations (i.e., sign language interpreter, Braille format, adaptive equipment) to enable people with disabilities to participate and enjoy recreation and education programs. If you require a wheelchair-accessible bus to participate in a day trip, please contact the Senior Center to arrange accommodations. Some trip destinations may not be fully accessible, and staff will share what they know to help you make an informed decision.

REFUND POLICY

The Colorado Springs Senior Center depends on class fees to pay instructors and to provide a variety of classes and activities. For this reason, classes may be cancelled due to low enrollment. Our refund guidelines ensure that we can retain quality instructors and not cancel classes unnecessarily.

Please review the guidelines below and ask questions before cancelling your registration.

- Payment in full is required at registration. A full refund or credit will be issued if you cancel more than one week prior to the start of the class or if the Senior Center cancels the class.
- Please let a staff member know if you want a refund or credit. If your original payment was made by credit card, a
 refund can be made to that card. If payment was made by cash or check, please allow 2–3 weeks for a refund check
 to be mailed to you.
- No refund or credit is given if notification is made less than one week before the class start date or after the class has started. EXCEPTION: A 50% credit will be issued if the cancellation is for a medical reason. The cancellation must be made within the time frame of the class.
- Credits must be used within 12 months of the issue date.
- Class fees cannot be prorated.



Is there anything better than sharing a meal with others? At Silver Key Connections Café, anyone 60 and older can enjoy


hot, nutritious meals five days a week for a suggested donation of \$3.50 per meal. Lunch is served Monday - Friday from 11:30 a.m. –

During the refurbishing process, the memory of each cell phone is flashed to wipe out any previous information stored on the phone. If you


